a/ Vaping

g/ Posters

h/ New Stand v New Stadium?

BR outlined what the issues are with allowing home fans in BRS and everyone agrees, although disappointing, it is understandable. We must provide covered seating and allows a saving with stewards being in and around all four stands.

i/ U21 team

PC explains we will not have a dedicated squad but we will have "ad-hoc" friendlies containing players that fall into a U21 or `B` side. Will utilize the loan market for players who need minutes.

j/ Big Screen

PC explains not happening right now, BG keen but extensive permissions needed – not given up but right now, no.

k/ Medway Council
